



COMMUNITY UMPIRE COMPETENCIES

The practical assessment requires the umpire to demonstrate the competencies during a minimum of one match. Evidence of competencies can be shown at any level of hockey in Australia, **including Hookin2Hockey and modified versions of the match.**

Match length: minimum of 45 minutes

Who can access: Hockey Australia or State/Territory approved Assessor

(Note: Assessors are not responsible for the umpire's performances in any future sessions).

MANAGE SELF

1. Dress according to local competition standards for umpiring activity
2. Apply self-management principles for personal health and safety
3. Identify roles and responsibilities involved in umpiring a match
4. Display a positive attitude towards umpiring

MANAGE ATHLETES

5. Apply the rules/ guidelines of hockey
6. Illustrate ability to recognise dangerous play and respond

MANAGE OTHERS

7. Work cooperatively with coordinators, parents/ guardians and other umpires

MANAGE ENVIRONMENT

8. Ensure environment is safe for activity
9. Awareness of Official's Code of Behaviour
