



HAW Representative Pathway

There are two Representative Pathways for Hockey Albury Wodonga:

- **The Hockey Victoria pathway (KNIGHTS).** This is via the Regional Zone Development Pathway Program and is for those players that have a desire to move towards Victorian State Selection
- **The Hockey Albury Wodonga pathway (REP).** This is via a number of local skills clinics and coaching culminating in a trip away to consolidate the skills and game craft learnt throughout the program. This pathway is directed at players who may be looking for a stepping stone for future selection in the RZDP or those players that want to learn something new and hone their skills to improve their hockey without regular travel to Melbourne.
- **The ACT pathway (State)** Nominate and register to trial. If successful in selection you may need to request clearance from HV

Regional Zone Development Pathway (RZDP):

Selection and Training

Nominate Online for Knights trials. These occur in Albury and Shepparton, alternating on a yearly basis. North East Knights teams will be selected at these trials.

The Knights team plays in the Junior State Championship which is played in varying locations in Melbourne (depending on the age group). It is held during one of the weeks of the Victorian School holidays and runs for four days, from Tuesday to Friday.

Competition costs are \$180 -200 approx. You must organise own transportation, accommodation & meals and these are at your own expense.

Draw will be provided when finalised by the Knights Coordinator. Details on who this is can be found on the HAW website under Representative/Knights. Training equally shared between Albury and Shepparton.

Draft Camp: Usually in September

All age groups at the Melbourne State Hockey Centre. Cost is approx. \$200. Organise transportation, accommodation & meals at own expense. Further information can be found on the Hockey Victoria website. You can nominate via Hockey Vic high performance section.

Albury Academy:

HAW run an all age groups Academy over the off season – date depends on the year. Cost approx \$50. Training sessions are run in Albury for 1 hour 30 minutes each

State Teams:

State Selections: dates February for u15 and U21 and U18 April and Aug for U13/14 outdoor for both States. Check their website for exact dates. Indoor State trials are October 13/15/18 and there is a tournament held to select U21 and open in November

VIC

All age groups

All costs to be met by players. 80% attendance required. Wednesday & Sunday training but Wednesday not compulsory. Negotiate with coach. Cost of uniform and trip as well as all travel, accommodation and meals are the responsibility of the player. Approximate cost for player \$3500.

ACT

For nominations

All costs are met by players. Monday and Wednesday night training, can be negotiated depending on coach for satellite training locally one night a week. Cost of uniform and trip as well as all travel, accommodation and meals are the responsibility of the player. Approximate cost for player \$2500. Players may require clearance from Hockey Victoria to play for ACT as this is our affiliated State.

Junior Country Championships May Venue: Melbourne (various)

Nominate via Rep form online. No cost for nominations. Dates for trial on the HAW web site. Selections held in Albury and can include fitness & skills test. Team Training dates will be organised by team coaches.

Cost is approx. \$120 if selected. Uniform costs (hoodie, walkout shirt, shorts/skort and socks) on top of this. Shirt is supplied. Members to organise their own accommodation & travel.
